Our Policies

- Conduct risk assessments of new suppliers to evaluate their modern slavery practices.
- Perform regular audits and reviews of existing suppliers.
- Require suppliers to provide declarations of their own compliance with the Modern Slavery Act 2015.

Training

We provide training to our employees to help them recognise signs of modern slavery and understand how to act if they suspect it is taking place within any part of our business or supply chain.

Our Commitment

We are committed to continuously reviewing and improving our processes to combat modern slavery and are dedicated to collaborating with industry partners, governmental bodies, and interested parties to achieve this goal.
